New Member Opportunity

- Students are invited to participate in the ***Widener Law Review Winter Write-on Competition*** to be held at Delaware Law School on Saturday, January 20, 2018 for an opportunity to join one of Widener's prestigious law publications.

Eligibility

- 2L Regular Division and 3L Extended Division
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 at the end of the Fall 2017 Semester

Competition Requirements

- Participants will be given a summary of a current legal issue, such as a recent controversial Supreme Court decision or a circuit split.
- Participants will also be provided with a packet containing an appendix of legal authority and comment-writing guidelines. The packet is closed – students may not include any research beyond the materials provided.
- Participants will then review the materials provided and have 4 hours to write a comment-style response to the prompt.

Membership

- Scoring is based on legal analysis, writing style, citation accuracy, organization, grammar, etc.
- GPA, resume, and statement of interest will also be considered.
- Participants with qualifying submissions will be extended offers of membership. New members will join Widener Law Review as staff editors in the Spring 2018 Semester.

Competition Entry

- Submit your resume, unofficial transcript, and statement of interest by January 18, 2018.
